After six years of extensive development and trials in conjunction with the University of Maine, Black Bear is pleased to offer for sale, its second generation machine, which is capable of resizing most grades of paper rolls in a fraction of the time it takes to traditionally rewind. According to Marc Cooper President of TFRG and Inventor of the Black Bear Machine, "As far as I am aware, our simple and relatively small roll sizer, is the most affordable and effective, commercially available machine of its' kind, in the Paper Industry today."

Black Bear has designed a more advanced second generation machine and will be conducting additional trials for perspective customers, as well as using the existing machine to perform roll resizing and repairing damaged rolls for TFRG and others, at its' new Gardner location.
